GENERAL RULES CONCERNING PLAYERS AND TEAMS

1. NUMBER OF PLAYERS PER TEAM

- The minimum number of players on a team roster is 12. A P/T player counts as half a player
- The maximum number of players on a team roster 18. A P/T player counts as half a player

_

2. MINIMUM NUMBER OF PLAYERS PER GAME

- If a team does not have enough players on hand to start the game (i.e. 3 players + a goalie, for Men's and Women's divisions, OR 2 women + 2 men + a goalie for Coed divisions), then the game is defaulted, and a \$75 fine will be levied without exception

3. PUNCH CARD AND CALLUP PLAYERS

- A Punch card is a player who signs up as P/T player and is not affiliated with any team and identifies himself/herself as a punch card player.
- A callup is a full-time player from another team that is called up to play with another team that is short of players
- The maximum number of games a P/T player can play is 10 games
- The maximum number of games a call up can play as a call up is 10 games.

4. RULE CONCERNING CALLUPS:

- Callups only from divisions below or within the same division if there are no divisions below.
- If a player registered, only in the women's league, then they cannot be a call up in the Coed Division. The same applies to players registered only in the men's divisions
- When a team has a call up/punch card player, they must be listed on the game roster and must be marked as CALL UP OR PUNCH CARD.
- If a team has a punch card or call up player during a game, the total number of players on the bench for that game cannot exceed 10.
- If the player being called up is a goalie, then they can be from any team in the division and must be regular goalie in the division
- A team cannot have more than 2 call-up or punch card players or a combination of call up and punch card, per game
- A P/T player on a team is not allowed to be a callup
- Before calling up players from other teams, a team must first post in the Punch Card Team Chat that they are looking for players. If nobody responds or the list is empty, then they can ask players from other teams. Failure to do this will result in a \$25.00 fine

5. RULE CONCERNING RESCHEDULING/CANCELLING GAMES

- Requests to postpone games must be done at least 3 weeks prior to the game otherwise it is a default which carries a penalty of \$75.00. There is also a rescheduling fee of \$85.00

6. RULE CONCERNING PLAYOFFS

- A full-time player who has not played a minimum of 3 games cannot play in the playoffs
- Punch Card Players cannot play in the playoffs.
- P/T players affiliated with a team can play in the playoffs provided they have games left on their card and have played a minimum of 3 games with the team.
